Minutes: Music School Faculty Meeting

Present at meeting were Miss Chun, Miss Loo, Mr. Orenstein and Mrs. Watkins.

The Pre-School Bazaar to be held on Saturday April 1st, was announced and teachers were asked to invite children to attend after classes that day.

The Kalihi - Palama Council will be having its annual meeting in the Music Building on Thursday March 23rd, and have asked that the Music School supply part of the entertainments. Since the Music School has been and will be called upon quite a bit it was decided that we should be prepared to meet as many of these requests as possible using as many different students as are prepared without calling upon the same ones too often.

The First Faculty Recital of March 24th, was discussed. The program when mentioned was discussed thoroughly as to content and presentation. Mr. Orenstein suggested inviting Mr. Liebrecht to assist on violin numbers. However, since the recital is to be a faculty recital as distinguished from other monthly recitals performed by guest artists, and due to the fact that we have already asked Mrs. Helen Carbaugh to perform on four - hand work, it was generally agreed that we reserve this suggestion until another time.

The performers Miss Loo and Mr. Orenstein were asked to submit items for their personal publicity, program arrangement of their numbers and guest list for recital.
