For the Friday and Saturday concerts the Children's Chorus will meet in the rehearsal room to the left and rear of the stage for the 6:45 p.m. warmup rehearsal.

The concerts this year will involve many performers and performing groups. Please ask your daughter to stay strictly with the chorus, remain quiet and composed during waiting periods of rehearsals. This will help eliminate some of the confusion and noise at rehearsals and performances.

REST PERIODS

The days from Tuesday the 22nd through the 26th will be tiring ones for the children. An afternoon rest period should be included in the daily schedule during that heavy week.

COSTUME

We hope to have all the 45 girls in the chorus in white dresses with black or very dark shoes. If this poses a serious problem for you please call Dorothy Moritz, 879525, early this week and discuss the costume problem with her. We may be able to help in getting a few dresses loaned for the occasion.

TRANSPORTATION

Please plan to take and pick up your child to and from the Farrington rehearsals and concerts as the Palama cars and staff will be tied up with the many other parts of the large program. If you positively have no means of transportation, call Dorothy Moritz for help. Your ticket for either nite will entitle you to enter free the other nite as a parent of a performer. Please simply mention this to the person taking tickets at the door.

CHORUS MEETINGS

Children's chorus will continue for the first three weeks in May, the 3rd, 10th and 17th, after which the group will rest until September since I will be on the mainland teaching for the summer.
