DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Edit and publish weekly bulletin on Settlement activities, particularly those of the Boys' Recreation Department.

Bill for

- a. Assemble, assimilate, and interpret news at Palama or news of interest (directly and indirectly) to Palama.
- b. Cut stencils for same
- 2. Publicity
 - a. Assemble, assimilate, and interpret Settlement activities, particularly those of the Boys' Recreation Department, to the public. This includes dispatching of write-ups to four local newspapers.
 - b. Present intelligently and convincingly to the contributing public, the outstanding features of Palama Settlement's service to the community through active membership in the Publicity Council of the United Welfare Fund.
 - 1. The Council meets at the YWCA once each month.
- 3. Promotion (contact-man between staff and membership)
 - a. Interpret departmental policies to membership making for a closer and better understanding between workers and members by lessening dissatisfaction, suspicion, and indifference to the Settlement program.
 - b. Interest the school and community in the "new" Palama (1937 A.D.) through primary-group contacts.

4. Miscellaneous

- a. Stand ready and able to "trouble-shoot" any job in the Boys' & Men's Department. This means: -
 - 1. Organizing and leading a club which will be a credit to the Settlement.
 - 2. Organizing and running any kind of athletic activity.
 - 3. Taking over clerical and secretarial duties
 - 4. Officiating
 - 5. Coaching
 - 6. Administrating & Supervising
 - 7. Participation in athletics

MINUMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. A sincere, undying loyalty toward Palama Settlement and the things for which it stands.
- 2. A better than average aptitude for journalism.
- 3. Willingness to work at all hours of the day and night in the interest of Palama Settlement.
- 4. Five years as member and employee of Palama Settlement.
- 5. One year of college with knowledge of principles of:
 - a. Psychology
 - b. Sociology
 - c. Physical Education
- 6. Ability to "produce" in order to lead and be followed.
- 7. Sound background of Athletics gained through participation and study.
