

MUSIC DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT  
September, 1951

Registration for the month of September totaled approximately twenty-five.

The entire month was filled with changes made necessary by the resignation of two staff members, Misses Emma Loo, and Dorothy Chun, the latter's resignation being effective Sept. 30, 1951. Miss Chun resigned to continue her studies on the mainland.

To replace Miss Loo, Mr. Willard Sueoka was engaged. However, with the vacancy created by Miss Chun's leaving Mr. Sueoka was appointed director.

New policies for the Music Department effective September, 1951 approved by the Music Advisory Committee, the Personnel Committee, and the Executive Board are as follows:

1. The registration fee of \$2.00 is now dropped in favor of membership. Membership rates are as follows:

2. The Music School will be known as Music Department.

3. The Music Department hours will be Monday to Friday 1:30 to 9:30 P.M., and Saturdays 8 - 12.

However, by request of interested people, and with the approval of the Director, classes may be held during the morning hours.

On Sept. 7, 1951 the Advisory Committee met and discussed the following changes to be recommended to the Executive Board and Personnel Committee for approval:

1. That adults be given a choice of membership privileges for \$5.00 or pay a yearly registration fee of \$2.00 for music privileges only.

2. That the hours of the Music Department shall be from Monday to Friday 9 A.M. to 9:30 P.M., Saturday 8 - 12, the lesson time to be scheduled according to the discretion of the director.
