REGISTER NOW FOR PALAMA'S NEW FALL PROGRAM

Registration is now open for Palama Settlement's fall program and the public is urged to register immediately as indications show registration will be quite heavy this fall. Registration will continue daily thro Friday 16 from 1:30 to 5 p.m. and from 6:30 to 9 p.m. and on Saturday morning from 8 to 12 noon. Activities will begin on Monday, September 19.

With an eye in serving the entire family, the following are the activities scheduled for the Fall program:

For children aged 8 to 14, there will be: Painting, drawing, fun with clay, household arts, playacting, cooking for both girls and boys, woodcraft for boys, judo, ukulele, movies, folk dancing, playground, swimming, gym activities and clubs. Yearly membership to Palama is required of all above activities except for playground. Some of the classes have a small additional fee.

For teenagers, the following are the activities: Sewing, swimming, weight-lifting and bodybuilding, judo, gymnastics, tennis, gameroom, clubs and parties. Palama will be open every evening Monday thro Friday from 6:30 to 9:30 for teenagers, young adults and adults.

For young adults and adults we have arranged for: Pottery (beginners and advanced) Japanese Flower arrangement, lauhala weaving, gift making (gift for all occasions), sewing, cooking, first aid (standard and advanced), English, tennis and clubs.

And, in addition to the above activities, we have something for the small fry too! It is a new program for 5 to 7 year olds. All children in this age group will have their own activities - crafts, singing, games, story-telling, playacting, playground activities including swings, jungle jims, skates and organized games. Any child within this age range is eligible to take advantage of this new program thro yearly membership to Palama Settlement.
