Mr. Kelly announced that the record room is nearing completion. He also announced that the new teacher has not made contact with us yet, although he has phoned her several times and has not been able to reach her.

Mrs. Wilkins requested that something be done soon on the problem of the boys playing on the porch located outside of her room. It has been necessary to speak to these boys almost every day.
