

GENERAL INFORMATION

Fall Session will begin September 13, 1948

1 - Registration
Registration for the fall term will be held the week of August 18 - 20 from 8 a.m. to 12 noon.

2 - Admission
Students are admitted throughout the school year upon completion of their basic tests, payment of the registration fee and payment of the fee for the first three or four-week sessions. Tests will be given the week of registration and the week of September 8 - 10. A limited number of students will be accepted as well as children of the community.

3 - Hours of Instruction
The school will be in session in the afternoon and on Saturday morning. For adults, special hours for classes and lessons will be arranged.

MUSIC

4 - Lesson Periods
Private instruction is given in half-hour periods. Class instruction is given in one-hour periods. Practice periods for those who have no piano at home -- hour, four or five times weekly.

5 - Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships are available for students who for economic reasons are unable to pay for lessons. Anyone may apply for scholarship at the school.

Students are promoted to higher departments upon passing examinations from the preceding departments.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Fall Session will begin September 13, 1948

1 - Registration

Registration for the fall term will be held the week of August 16 - 20 from 8 a.m. to 12 noon.

2 - Admission

Students are admitted throughout the school year upon completion of their music tests, payment of the registration fee and payment of the fee for the first three or four-week session. Tests will be given the week of registration and the week of September 6 - 10.

A limited number of adults will be accepted as well as children of the community.

3 - Hours of Instruction

The school will be in session in the afternoon and on Saturday mornings. For adults, special hours for classes and lessons will be arranged.

4 - Lesson Periods

Private instruction is given in half-hour periods. Class instruction is given in one-hour periods. Practice periods for those who have no piano at home -- $\frac{1}{2}$ hour, four or five times weekly.

5 - Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships are available for students who for economic reasons are unable to pay for lessons. Anyone may apply for scholarship at the Music School.

6 - Examinations and Promotions

Students are promoted to higher departments upon passing examinations from the preceding departments.

7 - Absence

No refund will be given except in cases of long illness.

8 - PIANO DEPARTMENT

A - Preparatory and Elementary I

- 1 private lesson each week
- 2 class lessons each week
- 1 practice period four or five times weekly at the school for those who have no piano at home.

Fee - \$2.50 per week for those who practice at home.

\$2.75 per week for those who use Music School pianos.

B - Elementary II and Intermediate I

- 1 private lesson each week
- 1 class lesson in theory required
- 1 class lesson elective (History, Chorus, Appreciation)

Practice periods - same as above

Fee - same as above

C - Adults

- 1 private piano lesson each week
- 1 or 2 one-hour class lesson each week
- Evening lessons and class to be arranged

Fee - \$2.00 per week for those who use Music School pianos.

(small additional fee for class sessions for adults).

9 - VOICE DEPARTMENT

A - Preparatory and advanced

- 1 private lesson each week
- 1 class lesson each week

- 1 one-hour practice period five times a week
(at school for those who have no piano at home)
Fee - \$2.50 per week - no practice period
 \$3.00 per week - practice included

Note: Students taking both piano and voice lessons are not required to go to more than 2 classes a week.

- Fee - \$4.50 a week - no practice.
 \$5.50 a week with 1½ hour practice.
(these fees include both piano and voice)

10 - CLASSES - Required

Theory classes are required with private lessons. For adults class work will be less detailed according to the needs of the pupils.

CLASSES - Elective

A - Free Classes

- 1 - Music School Students only
 - a - Chorus class once a week
 - b - Listening period - appreciation once a week
- 2 - Public invited
 - a - Informal listening sessions one evening a week

B - Modern Dance - Beginning and Advanced

2 one-hour classes a week

(Class limited to 20)

Fee - 50¢ per week for non-Music School pupils

C - Music for the Young

Rhythms, Music Dramatization, Toy Orchestra, Singing for the pre-school child.

2 one-hour classes a week - mornings or early afternoon.

Fee - \$1.00 per week
