Delight Hedges, well known as concert pianist, will be featured as one of the three principle concerto instruments in Bach's 5th Brandenburg Concerto at the third annual chamber music concert benefiting the Palama Settlement Music program and scholarship fund to be held Friday, Oct. 29 at the new First Methodist Church. Leola Wilkins, flutist and Cordelia Baldwin, violinist, will perform the two additional concerto instruments with the small Bach-orchestra. John Kelly, Jr., director of the Palama Music Department, will conduct the ensemble. The work, performed in Honolulu twice during the war years, is one of the classics in the field of instrumental concertos with the unusual feature of three solo instruments instead of one.

Dorothy Young ~~Winters~~, also on the staff at Palama and recent winner of a National Guild of Organists competition, will perform the Prelude and Fugue in D major, also by Bach. The First Methodist Church Choir under Mr. Kelly will sing the 4th Cantata from Bach's Christmas Oratorio with the chamber orchestra accompanying. Soloists will include Donald Vogel, bass, and Doris Reese, soprano.
