GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Registration

Registration for the summer term will be held the week of June 20th. from 8 a.m. to 12 noon. Registration fee is \$2.00. The term of 9 weeks is from June 27th. to August 27th. .

2. Admission

Students are admitted upon completion of tests and payment of registration fee.

3. Hours of Instruction

Classes and lessons will be arranged at time of registration.

4. Lesson Periods

Private instruction is given in half-hour periods. Class instruction is given in one-hour periods. Practice for those who do not have a piano at home one half-hour period four or five times weekly.

5. Scholarship

A limited number of scholarships are available for students who for economic reasons are unable to pay for lessons. Anyone may apply for scholarship at the Music School.

6. Examinations and Promotions

Students are promoted to higher departments upon passing examinations from the preceding departments.

7. Absence

Credit will be given in cases of long illness only. When ill the school must be notified up to two hours before the lesson on that day. Only when notified will lesson thus missed be made up.

8. Piano Department

A. Preparatory and Elementary Ia

1 private lesson each week

2 theory classes " "

fee: \$ 2.50 per week

B. Elementary Ib, II and Intermediate

- 1 private lesson each week
- 2 theory classes " "
- 1 Appreciation class each week
(Required)

fee: \$2.50 per week

\$2.75 " " if student practices
at School.

C. Adults

- 1 private lesson each week
- 1 theory class " "

fee: \$2.75 per week

\$3.00 " " for practice at school.

Note:

For adults the class work will be less technical and detailed than classes for children. Instruction will be given according to the needs and interest of the adult student.

9. Voice Department

Preparatory and Advanced

- 1 private lesson each week
- 1 theory class each week

fee: \$3.25 per week

\$3.50 " " for practice at school.

10. Both Voice and Piano

Students taking both piano and voice will be given a special rate.

- 1 private voice lesson each week
- 1 private piano lesson " "
- 1 theory class each week

fee: \$ 4.50 per week

\$ 4.75 " " for practice at school.

11. Special Classes

A. Required Classes

1-Theory

All students are required to attend theory classes.

2-Appreciation

Advanced students will be required to attend appreciation classes which are now given free.

3-Boy's Rhythm

This class will be required for all those who need to develop better response to rhythm and muscular coordination.

B. Music for the young

Rhythm-Toy Orchestra-Music Dramatization-
Listening and singing for pre-school children.

1 hour class period every day

Students may be enrolled from 3 to 5 classes a week.

Small fee will be charged.

Children from 4 to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ years old will be accepted.

C. Music for the Community

For adults who would like to understand and enjoy music an hour a week will be offered in which music will be presented in such a way that all will understand and enjoy classical music better. Parents of music school students are specially urged to attend, for it will give them some idea of what their children are getting from studying music.

12. Donations

Donations of money, music books, and records will be welcomed. The school is building up its library. We will appreciate your giving any music reference books, piano, voice, or choral music and records for which you no longer have use. Any material donated will be called for if we are notified. Donors of money may specify how they like to have the money used whether for scholarship fund, library fund, or concert fund, which makes it possible for some students to attend concerts who could not otherwise do so.
