I would like to make a request of the Community Service Committee to include a sum of \$200.00 for our Music Scholarship Fund for 1956. The money received for scholarship is used to help finance musical education of youngsters who otherwise could not afford music. Our practice in the past has been to try and get the families to assume as large a cost as they can of the total charge, and then to finance the difference out of our Scholarship Fund. This may mean that the Scholarship Fund is called upon for a sum of from \$1.00 to \$5.00 per month per child.

May I say thank you at this time for the generous donation which has been given to Palama in the past. We sincerely appreciate the help that you have given to so many deserving children and trust that this money will again be available for scholarships for the 1956 program year.
