

MUSIC SCHOOL MONTHLY REPORT
April, 1951

The month of April was marked by the annual faculty recital. Performing were Misses Emma Loo, soprano, and Hope Troyer, pianist. Miss Loo's songs were a group of Italian and English songs. Miss Troyer played Bach, Beethoven and Debussy selections among other numbers. About a hundred and ten attended the Recital which was held on April 21 in the Music Auditorium.

Student activities include: (1) The participation of five students who played piano solos at one of Likelike School's P.T.A. meetings. (2) Attendance at the Oratorio Society concert by several students. These students were the first to benefit from a gift of fifty dollars given recently to the school. It was decided that this fund be used to reward students who placed high in such tests with tickets to current concerts.

To educate parents as to their part in their children's musical education, two editions of pamphlets called "Parents' Editions" were ordered from the Keyboard Jr. Publications Inc., and sent out to parents of Music School students. Volume I no. 1 covered such subjects as:
