Results of the Poi Supper are as follows:

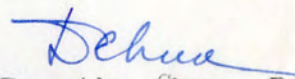
Total Poi Supper receipts	\$ 1,015.49

Ticket sales were topped by Director of the Settlement Mr. Shehtanian who sold forty-eight tickets, four times as many as the next person below him.
