PALAMA MUSIC SCHOOL

Opens September 2, 1946 (tentative)

A. Course of lessons for piano

8 half hour lessons at the piano (1 lesson per week)

32 half hour supervised practice periods at the music school for those who have no piano at home. There will be four practice rooms at the school.

8 hour class periods in rhythms, note reading and music history. Total--28 hours of music instruction per 8 week period.

Cost

\$16 per 8 week period for Palama members -- payable in advance.

\$18 per 8 week period for non-Palama members--payable in advance.

Membership at Palama can be had by grade school children for \$1.00 per year.

Because of limited facilities we will not be able to handle very many piano pupils and we shall reserve the right, after having consulted with teachers, parents and our staff worker, to select those children who will benefit most from such training.

In case of real hardship in any family where there is a child who should participate in the program please consult with Mrs. Alice Barnes, director.

B. Band

Band will be offered to those who have instruments. Palama has bond instruments to rent, but we hope to obtain some for the future. Cost will cover instructor's fee and music. Band classes will be held in large groups and members will be required to take a class in rhythms, sight reading, and music history.

C. String Instruments

Palama has a few string instruments which can be used by any student who wished to study. Fees and classes will be announced if there is sufficient dimand for instruction in strings.

D. Vocal

There will be no individual voice lessons at first. We hope to obtain the services of a voice teacher if there is a demand for a voice department. There is a fine group of young adults which meets one evening each week for chorus work. They sing sacred and secular music and learn the fundamentals of voice production. This group will continue as a part of the music school and anyone who wishes to join the group is most welcome. The fee for that has been a Palama membership which covers more than the music activity.

E. Theory

Each beginner will be required to take a class in elementary theory, rhythms and music appreciation for a certain period to be determined by the instructor after which the child may continue or not as he chooses.

Palama memberships give the child the following:

- 1. Use of the swimming pool
- 2. Privilege of joining a club
- 3. Arts and Crafts
- 4. Cooking and sewing
- 5. Folk Dancing
- 6. Participation in Palama parties at Hallowe'en, Christmas and Easter
