Minutes- Music Faculty Meeting

Teachers were asked about their reviewing of classes and private pupils for the exams scheduled for the third and fourth weeks of May.

Procedure of testing was discussed so that there would be a consistency of testing methods. Teachers were asked to enter the grades onto the grade records, test sheets and report cards.

Teachers were requested to submit these written exams before and after administering them to students.

Method of grading was discussed. It was recommended that teachers use the grade curve only when it was close or identical with the teacher's opinion of the student's ability.

Awards for the school year 1949 - 50 was considered.

Mrs. Abrams reported her findings as to possibilities of having awards made to order. There was no decision made because of the considerable cost involved. So the matter will be taken up by the Advisory Committee.

The matter of allowing young children to study modern music was discussed, being as it was beyond their ability to comprehend and appreciate. It was generally agreed that only students advanced and old enough will be assigned such studies. Other piano method books were evaluated.

The meeting was adjourned in time to teach.
