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The brilliant and world famous young pianist, Philippa Schuyler, will present a piano recital to the students, parents and friends of the Palama Settlement Music School on Saturday evening at 8:00 p.m. The recital, which is open to the public, is being presented without admission charge as a Christmas gift to the families of the Settlement Music School and to Miss Schuyler's many admiring friends in Honolulu who enjoyed her performances in the all-Gershwin concert with the Honolulu Symphony in September.

Miss Schuyler will arrive Friday evening by Japan Air Lines on her way to a challenging whirlwind concert tour of the Orient, the Near East, Africa and Europe.

The varied program will include concert works by Beethoven, Ravel and Mussorgsky and a group of folk songs from the Orient and South America arranged for piano.

Since the auditorium accomodates less than 200 persons the audience will be seated on a first-come, first-served basis. Miss Schuyler will be the house guest of the John M. Kelly's while here.
