Dear Parents:

The increase in fees for music lessons at the Palama Settlement Music School, which was mentioned to you earlier, is stated below. The increase will go into effect for the Spring Semester beginning January 26, 1959.

In order that no child will be deprived of his or her music study for reasons of economic hardship, we are prepared to grant partial scholarships. This scholarship money will come from the Community Chest for this specific purpose.

Scholarships are offered on the basis of financial need, after consultation with John Kelly, Music School Director and Dorothy Moritz, School Registrar.

The new rates are as follows:

<u>Instrumental lessons:</u>	<u>Private:</u>	<u>Group:</u>
17-week Fall and Spring Semesters	\$ 43.75	\$ 31.25
7-week Summer Session	20.00	12.50

The rates for those on partial scholarships at present will be adjusted proportionately. As in the past, the fees are due at the beginning of the semester but if necessary they may be paid on a monthly basis with the understanding, however, that they must be paid in full by the end of the semester. No child will be accepted for a succeeding semester if the previous bill is still outstanding. Please understand that economic necessity forces us to insist on this point - we would love to teach "for free"!

We hope that the above change in rates, which has to be made if we are to continue paying teachers a living wage, will not present too much of a problem to you. But, if it does, feel free to discuss your needs with us.
