Minutes of Staff Meeting September 8, 1959

Present: Mr. Larson, Ronald Tarr, Dora Ah Chan, Nora Hinckley, Carl Cunningham, Dorothy Moritz

Scholarship Drops: Mr. Larson requested that a report of the scholarship drops be given to him as soon as possible.

Teaching Schedule: Mr. Larson was informed that there are 10 more total hours to be scheduled or 20 - $\frac{1}{2}$ - hour teaching periods. Mr. Larson suggested to try to fill unfilled periods with non-fee group activities, e.g. harmonica etc. If possible to use staff members here to lead groups if not, effort will be made to bring some one else to lead these groups.

Children's Chorus: Carl Cunningham has expressed a desire to conduct Children's Chorus this year. The chorus will meet on Friday the 18th from 3:45 to 4:45 p.m. under the direction of Mr. Cunningham. Mr. Larson suggested trying the chorus without an accompanist, but if a teacher is free at that time, then the teacher can accompany the Children's Chorus.

Preparation Time: Dora Ah Chan asked Mr. Larson a specific question, "do you want a record of our preparation time? Mr. Larson replied "yes, I would like to know what you are doing for the hours you are being paid". It was decided by Mr. Larson that a record of preparation time will be kept.

Resale: Mr. Larson stated that the present resale system will be eliminated. Hereafter the parents are expected to purchase music that is needed by the students at the local music stores. Mr. Larson stated that he would like to have this new system given a fair trial.
