Mrs. Park gave a report on the material she has selected for the Children's Chorus to present for the concert in December. These include some folk songs, Christmas songs and selections from the "Peasant Cantata" and "L'Allegro". The possibility of McKinley auditorium (rental: \$100.) or Roosevelt (rental: \$65.) was discussed. It was suggested that inquiry be made on the completion date of Farrington School auditorium.

The selection of materials to be used for theory classes and the segregation of children for the specific classes were made.

Teachers were advised to contact their parents who should attend the first meeting for new parents scheduled for this Friday, the 24th at 7:30. It was also announced that an advisory committee meeting is scheduled for Oct. 4, a Band meeting for Oct. 8 and a professional staff meeting on Oct. 13. The staff was also reminded that the first rehearsal of the Children's Chorus will be held this Saturday, the 25th at 9:15 a.m. This presented the problem of contacting at least 80 children before Saturday. It was suggested that either the secretary be asked to work extra hours or have a volunteer worker come in to help.

A discussion was held on the problem of children who can only come on Saturdays for their lessons. It seems that this year many of our old students who were formerly in elementary schools are now in high school and can only come in after 3 or on Saturdays. This is creating a demand for these particular hours which are already heavily scheduled.
