

Music School Report for the month of December 1967

1. On December 19 we had a christmas recital for selected students at the music auditorium. the attendance was good and the students performed well. The new Palama Kiwanis Band was included in a recital for the first time. Refreshments were served after the recital.

Two more recitals were held on Dec. 23. The private students of Miss A. Chan performed. After the performance of the students Miss Chan played for the guests and everybody was invited to join in singing christmas carols. Refreshments were served.
