Many thanks for your interest in the music scholarship program that I outlined. I believe it is a "natural" for Rotary. Not only will Rotary be helping strengthen cultural activity through music but it will be helping a group of children who could not otherwise afford music.

For 1953 we have set ourselves a goal of \$3600 in scholarship money. Our total music department's budget is approximately \$12,500. You can see from this that most of our students do pay the \$5.00 monthly fee. We usually have 60 or more students that need help either for complete or partial scholarships.

It is my hope that the Rotary Club of Honolulu will take a share in this \$3600 goal. Some of the clubs have agreed to taking as their share one or more months of the pro-rata cost of our scholarship program.
