I would like to call to the attention of the Community Service Committee a project at Palama Settlement that I believe is worthy of your attention. The project is our Music Scholarship Fund. Every year we make scholarships available in our Music Department for youngsters that cannot afford to pay our fees of approximately \$5.00 per month, but who are good music students and should continue their musical education.

May I say that we also use this fund to give music instructions to boys and girls who have been known to the Juvenile Court and to the police because of their delinquent acts. We have been very successful in rehabilitating youngsters through our music education program. In many cases, these youngsters cannot afford to pay and, therefore, we have to grant them scholarships.
