Minutes of Staff Meeting held on May 25, 1954

A discussion was held on the success of the Parent's Nite. The majority of the parents were made up of mothers of new students enrolled within the last 3 months.

We now have more violin students waiting for assignment. It was pointed out that it would be necessary to transfer some of Miss Chock's piano students to other teachers to make it possible for her to schedule these violin students.

Miss Chock was asked if she would be willing to make a loan of her accordion for Mr. Wiley to use for demonstration until negotiations have been made for an accordion for Palama. Miss Chock agreed to bring the instrument in.

The possibility of beginning an adult music appreciation class immediately was discussed. This class would be made up of 4 adults who have requested a class of this sort. However, after a discussion it was agreed that with the summer day camp program and additional violin and accordion students to be scheduled it would be desirable to wait until September to start an adult class. It was also decided that these classes will be run on a semester basis.

Extra rehearsals for the Children's Chorus in preparation for the T. V. program have been scheduled for Wednesdays & Thursdays at 4:15. Mrs. Park was asked to time her program accurately so that that we would know how much time we have left for the narration.

Miss Chock asked if it would be advisable to distribute the remaining theory papers to the children to take home so that they may finish their books and start with new books in September. The Music Appreciation classes of Mrs. Park & Miss Chock will end this week due to the hour being used for extra rehearsals of the Chorus.
