Registration for music lessons at Palama Settlement Music School will be held beginning Monday August 27th to 31st inclusive, for the school term beginning Monday September 10.

Music instruction is given to children from four years and up and to adults. Private lessons will be offered in piano, voice, violin, viola, cello, bass, clarinet, trombone or any other instruments. Class lessons in the above subjects are given when requested.

All students enrolled are given two hours of classes in addition to their/^{one}private lesson a week. These classes include: Music-for-the- Young, Music Fundamentals, Rhythms, Toy Orchestra, Music Appreciation, History, Theory which includes: Eartraining, Sight-singing, Keyboard Harmony, and Glee Club

To adults are offered private or class lessons in piano or other instruments. If requested, adults may enroll in classes in Theory, Appreciation and other related subjects.

The closing exercises of Palama Settlement Music School will be held on Friday night, June 8 at 7:30 P.M. in the school auditorium.

Awards will be presented to students with highest scholastic ratings and perfect attendance by Mr. Dearon Shehtanian, Director of the Settlement. Displayed will be work done by students, among which will be original compositions and outstanding examination papers.

The "Little Glee Club", directed by Miss Emma Loo, will sing two numbers. Several adults who are enrolled in the Parents and Adult Division will perform on the piano in solos and duets.

There will be a reception after the program. All are invited to remain.

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Registration for the summer term will be held from June 15th to the 16th. The term begins on June 25 and ends on August 18th.

The curriculum will include private lessons in voice, piano, string, woodwind, and brasswind instruments; and classes in theory, appreciation; string, woodwind, brasswind instruments; scale and rhythm drill classes, and Glee Club. Evening classes in piano and other related subjects are offered for adults for a very small fee.

"Music for the Young" will again be offered for the children ages 4 - 6. The class will include rhythms, singing, listening, toy orchestra, song dramatization and music fundamentals.
