Date

During the month of March the enrollment stabilized at the level of a full teaching schedule for each of the teachers. New applicants are being placed on the waiting list. A small drop in total enrollment was mainly due to fluctuation in adult piano classes of the part time teacher.

Some new students are being assigned to hours between 1:15 to 2:30 in accordance with arrangements with the neighborhood elementary schools.

Chorus classes are being combined for the rest of April and May for rehearsals of the folk opera-game "The Wild Geese".

Guitar class of Wednesday evenings which was offered free to Palama members was temporarily stopped until a new teacher is contacted. First teacher was unreliable in attendance and did not return after the third class.

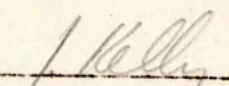
Applicants are being interviewed for position in the Music Department. All information is recorded, on application blanks and will be turned over to director with recommendations during latter part of April.
