



1989 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Neighborhood Development coordinated three major community events with the support of staff and volunteers from such diverse groups as Variety Club; Kamehameha, Punahou and Farrington High School students; Mayor Wright Mothers Group; and the Kamehameha Lions Club. The first issue of our agency newsletter, Ka Leo O' Palama was published for members and friends of Palama Settlement.

The Pakolea Program Pee Wee Football team won their conference championship and played in the Mele Kalikimaka Bowl at Aloha Stadium. The Junior Pee Wee Cheerleaders won first place in the annual Pop Warner Competition for the third year. Nearly 400 children participated in the football, basketball and Summer Enrichment programs.

In 1989, our Learning Center expanded to include a Computer Center which is equipped with 20 Apple II GS computers for use by the children enrolled in our educational programs. The center was funded by local Foundations and is coordinated into the vocational, GED and educational programs by our Director of Educational Development. Sports teams from local private high schools as well as individuals from Punahou and Kamehameha Schools served as tutors for our Pakolea youth.

Almost 70,000 people benefitted from the programs and services of the Recreation Department in 1989. This included volleyball and basketball leagues. A new addition to the Recreation program is the Leland Blackfield Youth Activity Center. The drop-in center for youth, ages 12 - 18 years, offers pool tables, ping-pong tables, fooseball games and other recreational activities. The adult supervised Center was open 7 days a week, free of charge to community youth.

The In-Community Treatment Program had a Summer Hawaiiana Project that coupled weekly instructional classes with experiential activities. Classes and workshops were also held in Health, Art and Family Violence. In 1989 a vocational training project with First Interstate Bank was initiated.
