Dear Mr. Clifford:

Thank you very much for meeting with Roy Oshima, Alan Ing, and myself. Enclosed is the information for which you asked. The current list of Palama-Kiwanis Band instruments is not yet complete by I shall send it to you as soon as possible.

As to your inquiry as to the money spent on Palama Settlement by the Kiwanis Club, the following applies:

Milk Fund: \$150.00 - The money has been used each year in its entirety. This money has been used to augment camp lunches, both day and residence camp.

Scholarship: \$180.00 - Money also used completely. The money in the past has been used for both day and residence camp. Last year it was used for the residence camp. Day camp - \$36 per child per six week session. Approximately 250 children have attended in the past years. This year, however, there is going to be a limit of 200 children between the ages of 7 and 12. Each day the children are served a hot lunch - milk is the beverage. There is no limit on food or drink. Residence Camp - \$45 per child for 11 day sessions.

Music: \$50.00 - The policy is handled by the First Insurance Company. I called the company and they are sending me a copy of the policy which I will in turn send on to you for your information. The last payment was for a total of \$91 for 3 years coverage.
