Minutes of Staff Meeting

January 17, 1955

Miss Janet Kimura, who will do a mural in the upper lobby of the music building, presented a preliminary sketch to the staff. She asked for suggestions and also presented the story of the scene. She will ask some of our students to pose for her and some of the older boys to assist her in the plastering. The program of music appreciation classes was discussed. It was suggested that Mrs. Ethel Thom, who is assisting us with part-time secretarial in conjunction with the Chorus, be furnished with keys to the office and kitchen. A suggestion was also made that a vessel or punchbowl be purchased for mixing juice which is served every Saturday at Chorus time.

Announcement was made that Lorin Gill will be using the dark room and one of the other rooms for meetings of the Camera Club on Monday evenings at 7.
