Monthly Narrative Rept  
June 12, 1952

Enrollment for the month of May was 128. At present it is 141 due to recent activation of part of the waiting list to fill in Mr. Don Wiley's time which became available when his duties at Iolani School terminated. Twenty three of our present students have indicated they will drop out for the summer nearly all of whom will return in the fall. Advance enrollment for the summer program is 21 but the results of the summer program publicity are not evident yet. Miss Kawamura, is bringing in 15 to 20 children (they will be scholarship applicants) next week for summer registration from Lanakila School.

The drop in enrollment during April and May compared to February (144) and March (143) was mainly due to the fact that it was undesirable to fill Miss Troyer's vacancies since she was leaving May 15. Other teacher's schedules were full. Mr. Wiley's time was not wholly available during his first 10 days, i.e., from May 12-25.

Month of May opened with a May Day program and Luau Supper which attracted around 220 people. Final receipts on the luau totalled \$79.00. \$29.00 remains in the club treasury (Dramatics-dance group) after disbursements for costume material, dance bamboos, a party for the club.

Mr. Wiley joined the staff May 15 to replace Miss Hope Troyer whose service terminated May 15.

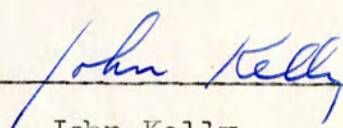

We have a good prospect, Mr. John Leal, to teach our summer Hawaiian Instruments classes.

The class schedule for summer is being posted this week for registration purposes. Teachers are assigned to the Day Camp Program (2½ hours per day-4 days per week). Financial arrangements for the latter have not been discussed yet with the Director.
